### Aintree National Sprint Series 28th April, 30th June & 8<sup>th</sup> September 2007 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Liverpool Motor Club will promote National B Permit Sprints on Saturdays 28th April & 30th June, & a National A/B Sprint on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 2007, at Aintree Motor Racing Circuit, Aintree Race Course, Melling Road, Aintree, Liverpool.
2. The meetings will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. MSA permit numbers will be advised in the Final Instructions.
4. The event on the 8<sup>th</sup> September is open to all registered contenders in the SBD Motorsport British Sprint Championship and all contenders must hold a National A (or Higher) Speed or Race Licence.  
The events on 28th April, 30<sup>th</sup> June and 8th September are open, under the National B permit, to all members of the organising club and to those competitors of the National B Permit Championships listed in Appendix 1 and are also open to members of the Association of North Western Car Clubs, Association of Northern Car Clubs, The Welsh Association of Car Clubs, and to the invited clubs listed in appendix 1. All competitors must produce a **valid Competition Licence, Club Membership card and any relevant Championship Registration Card at Signing On.**
5. The events will be qualifying rounds of one or more of the championships listed in Appendix 1.  
Because of the early publication of these regulations, please contact the Entries Secretary or check on our website at [www.liverpoolmotorclub.com](http://www.liverpoolmotorclub.com) for confirmation of Championships for each event. (The website will be updated as additional championships are confirmed). Qualifying Championships will also be confirmed in the Finals.
6. The provisional timetable of the meetings will be:  
Signing On from 07.00hrs followed by Scrutineering in your paddock position, individual times will be given in the final instructions.  
There will be an opportunity to walk the course from 07.15hrs to 08.15hrs. **It is strongly recommended that competitors new to the sport and those on their first visit to Aintree walk the course before the commencement of practice.**  
Practicing from 09.00 hrs  
Any competitor not signed on by 10.30hrs may be excluded  
Timed Runs from 13.30 hrs or earlier if conditions allow. All times will be confirmed in the finals
7. The length of course is 1,847 metres and consists of the motor racing circuit from the start to a point 325 metres after the exit from Bechers Bend. The track is approximately 9.75 metres (35ft) wide throughout
8. The events will consist of the following classes:
  - 1A: Roadgoing Production Cars up to 1400cc.
  - 1B: Roadgoing Production Cars over 1400cc. up to 2000cc.
  - 1C: Roadgoing Production Cars over 2000cc.
  - 2A: Roadgoing Specialist production up to 1700cc.
  - 2B: Roadgoing Specialist Production Cars over 1700c.

**Classes 1 & 2 must be completely road legal and come with a current Tax Disc, Insurance & MOT Certificate where required. You may be asked to produce these at Scrutineering.**

  - 3A: Modified Production Cars up to 1400cc.
  - 3B: Modified Production Cars over 1400cc. up to 2000cc.
  - 3C: Modified Production Cars over 2000cc.
  - 3D: Modified Specialist Production Cars.

**Cars in Class 3D must comply with GR L.12 with the exception of L12.1.2 which will be substituted by L11.1.2**

  - 4A: Sports Libre Cars up to 1700cc & Hillclimb Super Sports Cars.
  - 4B: Sports Libre Cars over 1700cc.
  - 5A: Racing Cars up to 1100cc.
  - 5B: Formula Ford 1600 Racing Cars manufactured before 1 January 1994
  - 5C: Racing Cars over 1100cc. up to 1600cc.
  - 5D: Racing Cars over 1600cc. up to 2000cc.
  - 5E: Racing Cars over 2000cc.
  6. Classic Cars manufactured before 1972 (handicap)

Single Make Championship classes may be added as required for each of the events.  
**All vehicles must comply with L10 – 15 and GR's E and Q as applicable (2007 MSA Year Book).**

8a **Equivalence**

Forced induction equivalence; multiply capacity by 1.4  
 Diesel engine equivalence; multiply capacity by 0.714  
 Forced induction diesel engine equivalence; multiply capacity by  $1.4 \times 0.714 = 1.00$   
 Rotary engines equivalence; multiply capacity by 1.5  
 Forced induction rotary engine equivalence; multiply capacity by  $1.4 \times 1.5 = 2.1$

## 10. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally 14 days before the appropriate event. The entry fee is £85.00, Liverpool MC Members £82.00. (Each entry fee includes MSA per capita Fees of £18.40 (B) or £18.60 (A).

All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. A separate form must be completed for each event entered. Post dated cheques will be accepted as long as they are dated a **minimum** of 3 weeks before each event. The club reserves the right to pass on to the competitor concerned any charges incurred if their cheque does not clear at the first presentation

12. The maximum entry for each Meeting is 145.  
The minimum is 80.  
The minimum for each class is 3.

Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

**The first 100 entries will be selected in order of receipt; the remainder will be selected at the discretion of the organisers.**

**Cancelled/Withdrawn entries:** In order for a cancelled/withdrawn entry to be considered for a refund the organisers must be in receipt of written notification (written notification includes faxes and e-mails).

Entries withdrawn not less than 10 days prior to the event will be refunded less an administration charge of £15.00.

Entries withdrawn less than 10 days prior to the event may only be eligible for a refund of the MSA fee.

In both cases refunds will be at the discretion of the organisers.

14. Competitors will be identified by competition numbers, which **WILL NOT** be supplied by the organisers.
15. Starting order will be determined by classes.  
Cars will start singly in class order and each class in numerical order.
16. The starting signal will be a green light and the method of timing is Automatic Class E.  
The finish line will be indicated by chequered marker boards.
17. Competitors will have the opportunity of two practice runs, having first had the opportunity to walk the course prior to the course being opened for competition.
18. Each driver shall be given a minimum of two runs in the same car in each class entered, the fastest run to count for the results - L9.5.1.
19. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after each run or following the end of the event. Results will be displayed on the notice board in the clubhouse.
20. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with O5
21. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the MSA General Regulations, except as modified below:  
L9.5.6. Ties: In the event of a tie occurring, a result shall be obtained by taking the total times of the best two runs, the lesser total being declared the winner.
22. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following, which are modified:  
E7.1.4 A novice shall be a driver who has not won an award in a competition of similar status or higher status within the last three years.  
L9.2.3. A driver may drive up to two cars, each in a different class.
23.
  - a. Competition numbers must be supplied and fixed in accordance with Technical Regulations L9.2.5 and **must be in place before presenting the car for Scrutineering.**
  - b. **All vehicles must be fitted with a Timing Strut L10.9.1.**
  - c. All vehicles must comply with the silencing levels E12.17. There will be an official Noise Test carried out before morning Practice Runs and further checks may be made during the event.
  - d. A speed limit of 10 M.P.H. will apply in the paddock, the penalty for exceeding this or for reckless driving in the paddock or any public area is immediate exclusion.
  - e. Competitors are reminded of the requirement for a **Speed National 'A' (open) or Race National "A" licence** (E2.15.5) if their car is a Racing or Sports Libre car, manufactured after 31/12/60, is over 2000 c.c. (or 1428 cc if force induction), unless the car is currently licensed for use on the public highway and **competes in the event in a road legal condition.** Please refer to L7.1.5.
24. A wide variety of hot and cold meals, drinks and snacks will be available in the golf centre, (adjacent to the paddock), during the event.
25. **The entrance gates will be open on the Friday evening until 9.00pm for campers. There will be a charge of £10.00 for camping payable on arrival directly to the Aintree Golf Centre staff who will then supply a camping pass. These must be obtained before 9.00pm & displayed in your vehicle otherwise you will not be allowed to camp overnight. Gates will be locked from 21.45hrs on Friday evening to 06.30hrs on Saturday morning with no exit or entry between these times.**
26. No trade sales may be undertaken at the circuit without the prior written permission of the organisers.
27. A strict 10 mph speed limit will be enforced in all public areas. Competitor and support vehicles must not exceed this when driving into and from the paddock. **All vehicles must be parked OFF the paddock road.**
